Dear Parents/guardians

We are hoping that everyone is still keeping well and getting ready for the start of our new school year. We have been working very hard with a large number of our staff in school rearranging and organising classrooms and putting systems in place to make the school as safe as we possibly can. We are looking forward to seeing all our pupils again and to working with them and you, their families, in a different but positive way.

We are not looking for you to send in a large amount of resources as we hope to make decisions at class level once we are all back. However, I would like to request the following items to be sent in initially:

- If your child has intimate care needs or a previous intimate care plan please provide
 - i.) A Ziploc bag containing all intimate care products required to meet his/her needs – to include wipes, creams etc.
 - ii) You should also, initially, provide antibacterial wipes and hand sanitiser. This may or may not be used as our first preference for our children would be handwashing, however there may be times when sanitiser or wipes may be the easiest and most readily available option.
- A Ziploc bag containing everything your child will need for feeding/lunch. Please provide all plates, cups, and utensils etc. for their use as required. Unfortunately it will be difficult to heat meals as we did in the past. We would ask that you use a food flask for hot foods. Please ensure that the drink has a secure screw on lid.
- Change of clothes in a clean plastic bag
- Home school communication book to be provided as usual. Teachers will exercise all hygiene practices when writing in the diary and would ask that you do the same at home.
- Please ensure that you write your child's name clearly on all items.
- All items will be returned home for washing, sanitising and food waste for disposal.

This is the start of a new year and new approaches, your help is important to us. We will be in touch with you along the way to keep you informed of any additional requirements or changes. Thank you for your support and patience throughout all of this
