I would like to ask you for your continued support over the next few weeks in particular. If your child has any cold like symptoms, coughs, sneezes, sore throats etc. please err on the side of caution and keep him/her at home. We are aware that it, more than likely, may not be Covid related but they may still feel unwell. Bugs and viruses can spread rapidly in a school like ours due to staff working in close proximity with our children. This can have a knock on effect on staffing and our ability to maintain the appropriate level of cover required for each class.

I know that with the recent closures we have all had to live with, everyone wishes to get back to what should be everyday life for us all, however, as a school we cannot be complacent. We have limited access to substitute staff and I am very reluctant to close classes, unfortunately at this early stage in the term this has already happened. Please understand that, in accordance with our plan, classes will close in the event of not being able to access substitute cover. We are trying to prevent this from happening by asking for your co-operation

Everyone is working together to ensure that this is a positive term for our pupils and that they are safe and happy. Your continued support is very much appreciated at this time.
